This liding, in the process of being converted from office to residential by Chicago veloper Draper and Kramer, was raw; a blank canvas, if you will. "We were allowed totally recreate it," says Rosenberg, principal and partner of his namesake firm.

e plans drawn up by the architecture firm handling the conversion, Chicago's oth Hansen, called for a four-bedroom apartment, but Rosenberg, Kowalski and it client felt this layout would de-emphasize the views, and relegate them to up where people went primarily to close their eyes. So, "they scrapped the floor in and really put their own stamp on it," says Joe Sperti, one of the architects o headed the project's design team for Booth Hansen.
