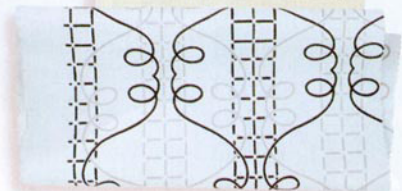


MALABAR HILL
