

Constantly stimulating the imagination of owners and designers, bespoke furniture maker Silverlining has unveiled a new collection of wood colours, textures and finishes. A showcase of the new colours comes in the form of 'Cascading Blue', a 1.7 metre high wood marquetry artwork that references traditional 18th-century Japanese imagery through digital design and production. The artwork comprises more than 800 pieces of dyed veneer – achieved by Silverlining's saturated colour technology, and finished with a clear

## MANUFACTURE DE MONACO

Porcelain manufacturer and purveyor to the Prince of Monaco, Manufacture de Monaco has collaborated with Königliche Porzellan-Manufaktur (KPM) of Berlin on the Kalypso table service line as part of its newly launched Yacht Collection. The overall look of each set is inspired by Trude Petri's 1938 design, characterised by clean lines, while the plates feature clear breaks between the rim and the centre – in the same style as 17th-century pewter plates.

Each piece is handpainted at KPM's

facility using the painstaking method of applying three colours under glaze and firing at differing high temperatures.

A second round of handpainting draws the 24K gold motives and enhancement lines.
