1 Caracas, a new wallcovering by **Nobilis**, brings lush tropical foliage and exuberant color to a room. The design is available in five colorways; white (COS102) and green (COS103) are shown. nobilis.fr. **2 Rose Tarlow**'s handcrafted Penny Lane table lamp updates the geometry of minimalism, pairing an olive ceramic base with an identically shaped paper shade.
