





he UK is gaining traction in the design world, with annual events like London Design Week and the London Design Festival, which includes a design forum and fair, site-specific installations and collaborations with the Victoria & Albert Museum. Many British brands have eschewed tradition for a more modern approach, with a delightful outcome. Among those brands stepping out of their comfort zones to experiment is Romo, based in Nottinghamshire. Its new Black Edition includes the wallcovering Iridos, in Anthracite, part of the Herbaria collection (above). Zoffany, the UK-based maker of fabrics and wallcoverings, brought to Deco Off in Paris the Phaedra collection (above right). The Thebes stool from Soane (right) recalls classic ancient Egyptian design and is handcrafted by rattan weavers in Leicestershire.
